HAZARD MITIGATION PUBLIC FORUM

Hazard Mitigation Plan

November 10, 2010

Goals

- ☐ Establish activities that should reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property
- ☐ Provide communities with a comprehensive guide for future mitigation efforts
- ☐ Provide communities the capability to identify their areas of risk as well as assess the magnitude of those risks and develop strategies and priorities to limit those risks
- ☐ Keep all jurisdictions compliant with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Grant Funding)

Hazards

- ☐ The Mitigation Overhead and Development Committee determined the county to be susceptible to the following hazards:
 - Severe Storms (Summer and Winter)
 - Flooding (Dams)
 - Tornadoes
 - Droughts (Wildfires)
 - Earthquakes

Hazard Profiling

- ☐ 3 step process used to profile hazards
 - FEMA database referenced
 - National Climate Data Center (NCDC) referenced
 - State of Ohio Hazard Mitigation Plan Update (2008) referenced
- ☐ These references gave us historical information about the hazards the county has faced within the past 60 years
- ☐ The research compiled gave the overhead and development committee the ability to rank the hazards based on past events.
- ☐ The following list shows the committee's ranking of hazards with #1 being the hazard of most concern:

1. Summer Storms	4. Tornadoes
2. Floods	5. Droughts
3. Winter Storms/Ice Storms	6. Earthquakes

Summer Storms

- ☐ Thunderstorms
- ☐ High Winds
- ☐ Lightning
- ☐ Hail

- ☐ Severe summer storms have the highest likelihood of occurring

- ☐ NCDC database has 311 storm events recorded since 1950

- ☐ \$76 million in damage over that 60 year period

Floods

- ☐ Flash Floods – product of heavy localized precipitation in a short period of time

- ☐ Riverine Floods (Flood plains) – product of precipitation over a longer time period and over a given river basin

- ☐ NCDC database has 62 flood events recorded since 1950

- ☐ \$6 million in damage since 1993

Floods continued

- ☐ Dams
 - Butler County has 51 active dams
 - ☐ Class 1: 8
 - ☐ Class 2: 8
 - ☐ Class 3: 14
 - ☐ Class 4: 21
- There are 3 abandoned dams, 7 unclassified dams, and 58 exempt dams, which have been determined by ODNR to not constitute a hazard to life health or property.
- Butler County does not have a significant history of dam failure
- The State of Ohio Dam Safety Program is in place to monitor all dams

Winter Storms

- ☐ Blizzards
- ☐ Ice Storms
- ☐ NCDC database has 50 winter storm events recorded since 1993
- ☐ \$19 million in damage since 1993
- ☐ Annual amount of snow county receives a year is 24 inches

Tornadoes

- NCDC database has 15 tornado events recorded since 1950

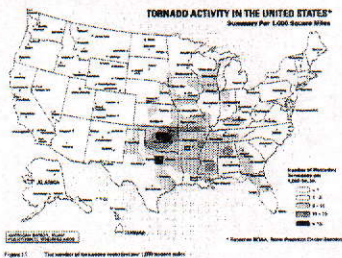
- \$60 million in damage over that 60 year period

- 1 death and 31 injuries

- 2 F4 and 1 F3

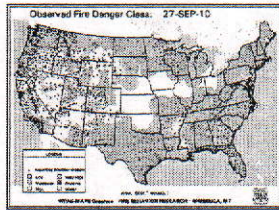
SCALE	WIND SPEED	POSSIBLE DAMAGE
F0	40-72 mph	Light damage: Branches broken, roof tiles blown away, damage.
F1	73-112 mph	Moderate damage: Trees snapped, mobile homes pushed off foundations, roofs destroyed.
F2	113-157 mph	Considerable damage: Shingles blown off, windows shattered, cars overturned, some homes destroyed.
F3	158-206 mph	Severe damage: Trees uprooted, cars lifted off the ground, strong walls blown away, some houses completely destroyed.
F4	207-249 mph	Devastating damage: Forest leveled, houses blown away, cars thrown 100 yards or more in the air.
F5	250-312 mph	Unimaginable damage: Strongly built homes completely blown away, automobiles or ships tossed great distances.

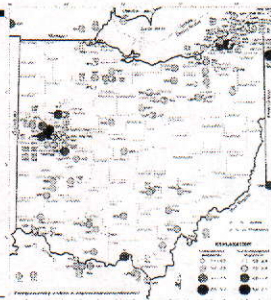
Droughts

- ☐ Abnormally dry weather that can be a precursor to other disasters
- ☐ NCDC database has 2 drought events recorded since 1950
- ☐ No information on cost of damage
- ☐ Wildfires
 - NCDC has no significant wildfires taking place in the past 50 years
 - However, 130,000 acres of farmland that could be susceptible



Earthquakes

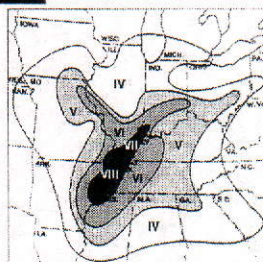
- ☐ Ohio has experienced more than 120 earthquakes since 1776
- ☐ Butler County has never had an epicenter directly within the county
- ☐ However, earthquakes have been in very close proximity located in northern Hamilton County and southern Montgomery County, both of which have had direct impacts on Butler County.



Earthquakes

Continued

- ☐ Butler County's close proximity to the New Madrid fault line makes the odds of an earthquake affecting the county fairly high
- ☐ Geologists believe the New Madrid fault has a high probability of activity in the next 50 years



Vulnerability Assessment

- ☐ A five-step process was followed to estimate the possible cost and impact of the hazards just reviewed:

- Inventory critical facilities
- Determine potential dollars lost
- Evaluate impact on infrastructure and general population
- Evaluate property damage, loss of life, and economic losses
- Determine and prioritize the probability, geographic extent, and magnitude of the hazards

- ☐ We inventoried 234 critical facilities in the county. The chart below breaks them down by category:

Potential Dollars Lost

- ☐ Calculated the impact of the given hazards in terms of property damage and loss of property use.
- ☐ This approach did not predict which facilities will be hit by which hazard, but it instead provided a general estimate of the level of damage that would be expected based upon available data.
