

4.0 PLAN ADOPTION

The final step in the Auglaize County mitigation planning process was planned adoption. The county followed the formal process for state and federal plan review and local jurisdiction adoption this section describes the process and identifies the date relevant to the plan approval adoption and expiration adoption resolutions from jurisdictions are also included this was being done by the Auglaize County-wide Emergency Management Cooperative Board.

4.1 FEDERAL AND STATE PLAN APPROVAL

Review by the planning team, the mitigation plan was submitted to the Ohio Emergency Management agencies Mitigation Branch on October 3, 2018. Auglaize County-wide Emergency Management Cooperative Board is waiting on recommendations and make revisions and prepared the plan for submission to the Federal Emergency Management agency FEMA.

4.2 LOCAL ADOPTION

Once conditional approval is received from FEMA the Auglaize County-wide Emergency Management Cooperative Agency will initiate the local plan adoption process.

The plan maintenance process will be ongoing throughout the five-year period, as described in section 1.0, the planning process. The detailed plan of action that Auglaize County will follow to update the plan before this expiration date should be in place by mid 2021 to ensure that the plant is updated and approved before the expiration date.
