

Salvage on-line scheduling – Frequently asked questions

Q: What documents do I need to bring to the salvage inspection?

A: You must bring your driver's license, the Ohio salvage title with your name on the front and the full sized 8 1/2 x 11 prepaid receipt from the License Bureau. You must also bring all of the original receipts for any parts that were replaced on the vehicle. Absolutely no photocopies of these receipts or it will fail the inspection.

Q: Are receipts from EBAY/PAYPAL accepted?

A: No. You must have the original receipt.

Q: Does the owner of the vehicle have to bring the vehicle to the inspection?

A: No.

Q: Is an assigned title acceptable?

A: No. The name on the front of the title must be the current owner of the vehicle.

Q: Where do I purchase the \$53.50 salvage inspection receipt?

A: Any Ohio Deputy Registrar's location.

Q: If I fail the inspection for any reason, will I have to pay another \$50?

A: No. You will be advised of what will need to be corrected and you will not forfeit your inspection receipt until those corrections are made.

Q: How do I obtain a salvage title?

A: You will need to apply for a salvage title at a local clerk of courts title office.

Q: Does a vehicle have to be ready for highway use prior to the inspection?

A: Yes. The vehicle must be in compliant with Ohio Revised Code section 4513.
